The Fourth Doorway To Becoming A Financial Shaman

The Paradox:

Wouldn't that pain the messenger did not intend also happen FOR their evolution and growth by exposing outdated beliefs? No person is responsible for anyone else's feelings or emotions, however, a shaman can hold space to help people process emotions if they shift negatively and ask for help, of course. So how responsible is the shaman for the message if those who are hurt don't ask for help?

The Threshold:



I will tell you over and over again that I don't have a message because I'm not a messenger. But mainly because I am here to elevate your heart's wisdom and make your heart the place you go to help make decisions. But since you are not practiced at that yet it is easy to lean on the wisdom coming through my heart as a foundation until you get the hang of listening to the messages coming from within yourself. However, do not get lost in believing we have the same truths, the same perceptions, or the same calling to fulfill in the same way. I am here to teach, that is all.
